Charles A. Lindbergh: “Flight and After Flight”

FORT MYERS, FL (August 15, 2007) In honor of the 80th anniversary of Charles Lindbergh’s solo flight from New York to Paris, the 2007 Lindbergh Symposium will focus on the life of this extraordinary man. This two-day conference will include a selection of speakers, recordings, and videos that cover his life and legacy—from that historic flight in 1927 to his work and contributions in the fields of aviation, medicine, intelligence, and archeology, to his pioneering concern for the environment.

Speakers on Friday include **Tom Crouch**, senior curator of aeronautics at the Smithsonian National Air and Space Museum, **Sergei Sikorsky**, son of Igor Sikorsky and past president of Sikorsky Aircraft, **Dr. Richard Hallion**, Alfred Verville Fellow in the Aeronautics Department at NASM, prize-winning historian **Erik Berg**, and **Dr. Theodore Malinin**, Director of the Tissue Bank at the University of Miami, and co-author of a publication on perfused bioreactor technology with Charles Lindbergh.

On Saturday, November 17, a series of panelists will present short commentaries with general discussion on various aspects of Charles Lindbergh’s life. A brunch is included.

The events will be held at the historic Army and Navy Club in Washington, D.C. where Charles Lindbergh worked on his Pulitzer Prize winning book *The Spirit of St. Louis*.

The cost is \$175 per person for the Friday Symposium; \$50 for the Saturday Brunch.
